

BTEC Tech Award Health and Social Care

Pupils in Maple study the new BTEC Tech Award Health and Social Care which is designed to develop and promote knowledge, understanding and skills in the subject.

The qualification consists of three units

Component 1 - Human Lifespan Development –

Aim - to understand how we grow and develop throughout our lives

Assessment - two internally assessed assignments; 30% of the total course

Component 2 - Health and Social Care Services and Values

Aim - get to know how the health and social care sector works and the care values lie at the core of it

Assessment – two internally assessed assignments; 30% of the total course

Component 3 – Health and Well Being

Aim – to develop knowledge and understanding of improving health and well being

Assessment - externally assessed task in which pupils produce a health and well being improvement plan for an individual; 40% of the total course

When pupils join the course they sit a baseline assessment test which is used with other data to give a predicted grade for the end of the course. Pupils progress is monitored each half term to ensure that they are making progress and on track to achieve their predicted grade. Ongoing advice and support is given to all pupils on how they can achieve or exceed their predicted grade.
