

Maths at Maple

Pupils in Key Stage 3 follow the Maths course in preparation for GCSEs. They are assessed each half term and given a points score based on their results. The course covers many topics which can be categorised under the headings of number, algebra, ratio, geometry, probability and statistics.

Pupils in Years 10 and 11 follow the GCSE Maths course. They may take exams at foundation level, if they are expecting to get grades 1 to 5, or higher level, if they are expecting to get grades 4 to 9, with grade 9 being the highest. At both levels the course covers number, algebra, ratio, geometry, probability and statistics. Assessment is at the end of Year 11 and consists of one non-calculator exam and two calculator exams.
