| Intervention | Reason | Cost | Impact |

| Accelerated reader | To improve the reading age of pp pupils | £1259.50 | 100% of pp pupils on the scheme progressed. The average amount of progress was 1.4 years in 1 academic year. |
| Breakfast club | Improve the health and to ensure they are ready to learn | £1000 | Pupils choices are now observed to be fruit rather than sugary cereal bars |
| Purchase of iPADS and trolley | Motivation of pupils and access to educational apps | £3000 | 100% of pp pupils have used iPads in lessons and 95% of pp pupils made good or expected progress last year. Self-reporting indicates that pupils enjoy using iPads for their learning and in social time. |
| Staff training on the use of iPADS | To ensure staff can use them for teaching and learning | £600 | All staff trained in the use of iPads. Lesson observations show increased use of iPads |
| 1:1 learning mentor support | Targetted interventions for pp pupils | £975 | LM has completed specific pieces of work with pp pupils. 90% of pp pupils reached their target GCSE grade |
| Taxi's | Provided when pp pupils have struggled to attend | £250 | Attendance improved by an average of 22% when this was in place |
| Attendance rewards | Motivator to attend | £44 | Attendance of pp pupils is comparable with the rest of Maple pupils |

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| Post cards sent home for good effort and behaviour | Motivator to work hard | £50 | Pupils and parents report that this has had a positive effect on classwork and homework. |
| Forrest schools | Motivator to engage | £3800 | 100% of pp pupils within mulberry access these sessions. |
