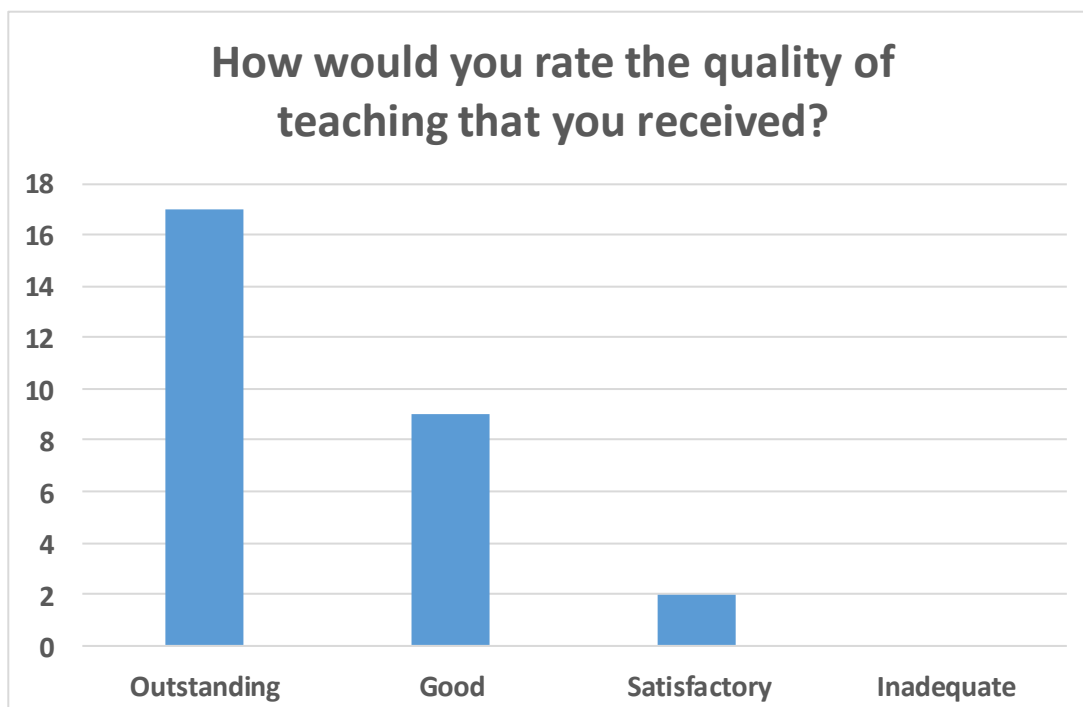

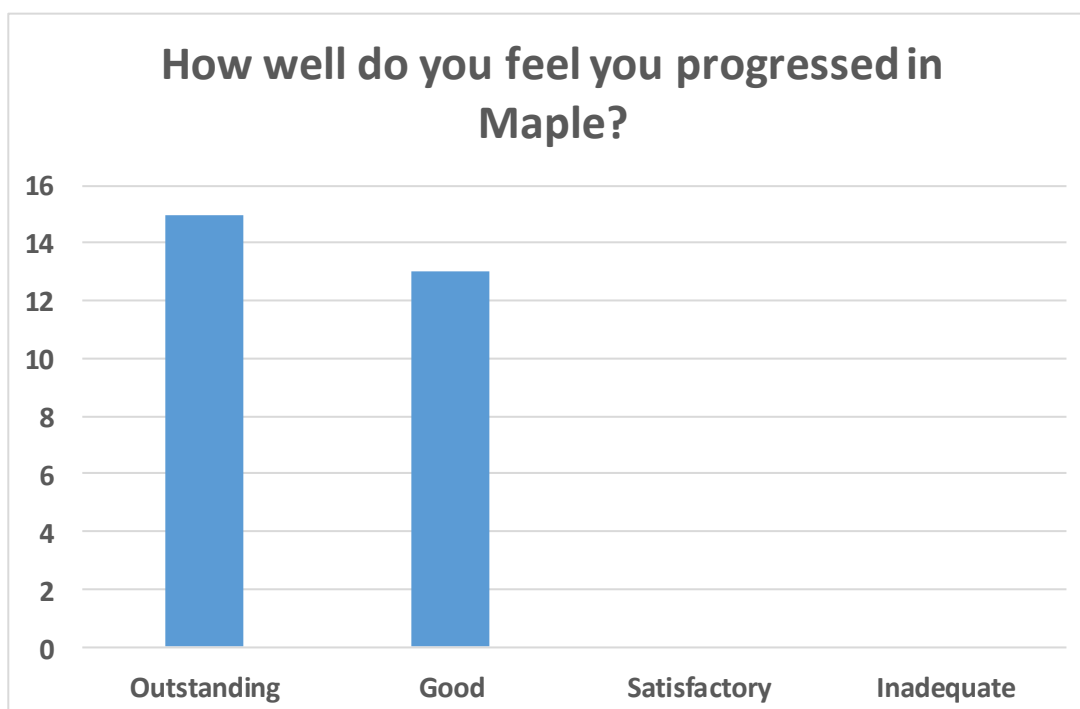


We asked our pupils at the end of the academic year to fill in a questionnaire about their time at Maple. Altogether we had 28 responses

Question 1

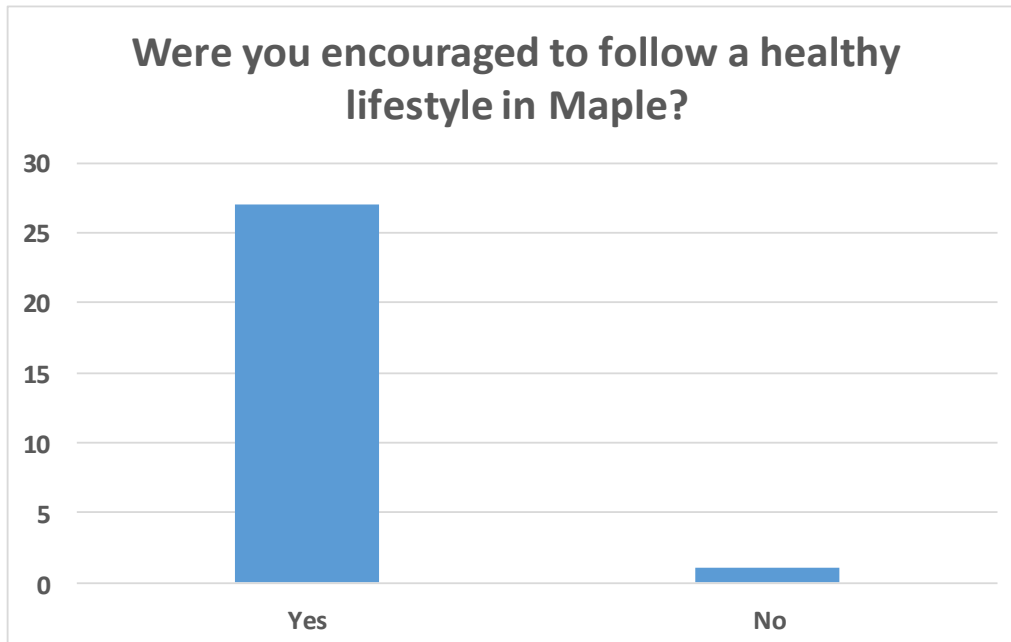
93% of pupils rated the quality of teaching they received as good or better and 61% said it was outstanding.

Question 2

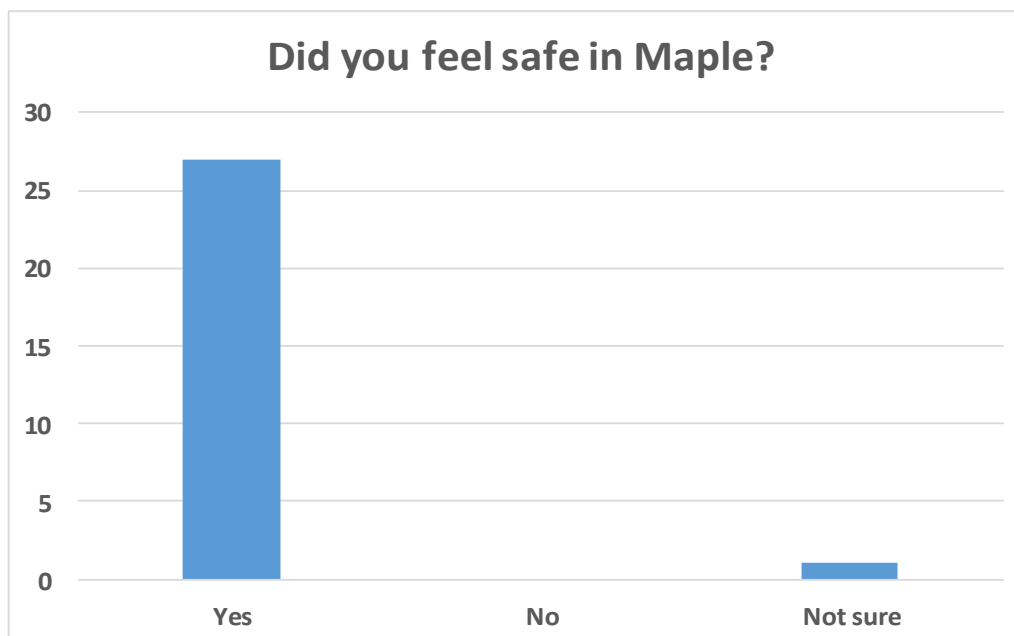


All pupils felt they had made good or outstanding progress.

Question 3



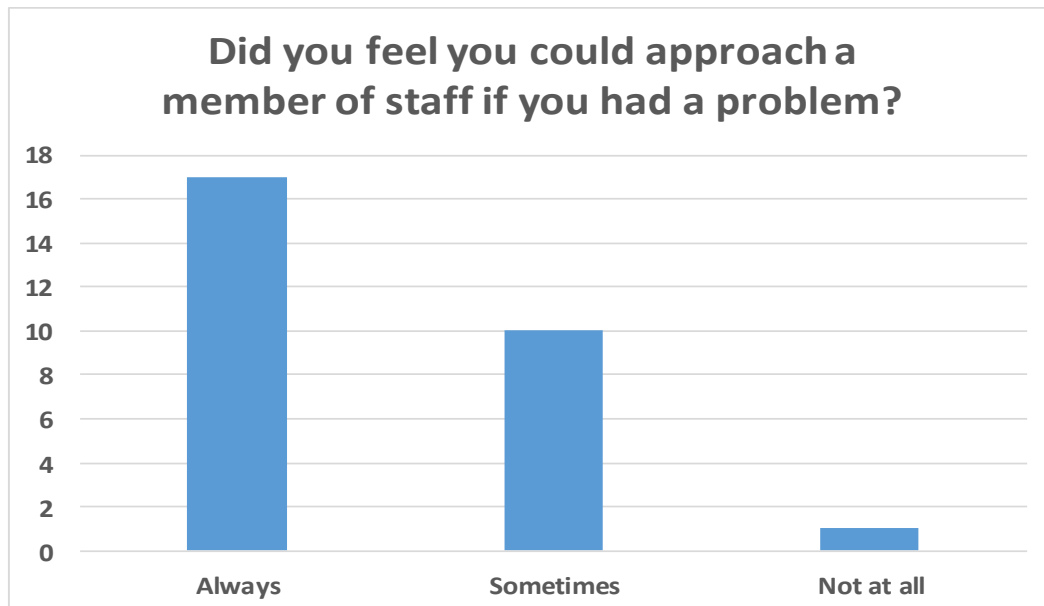

Question 4

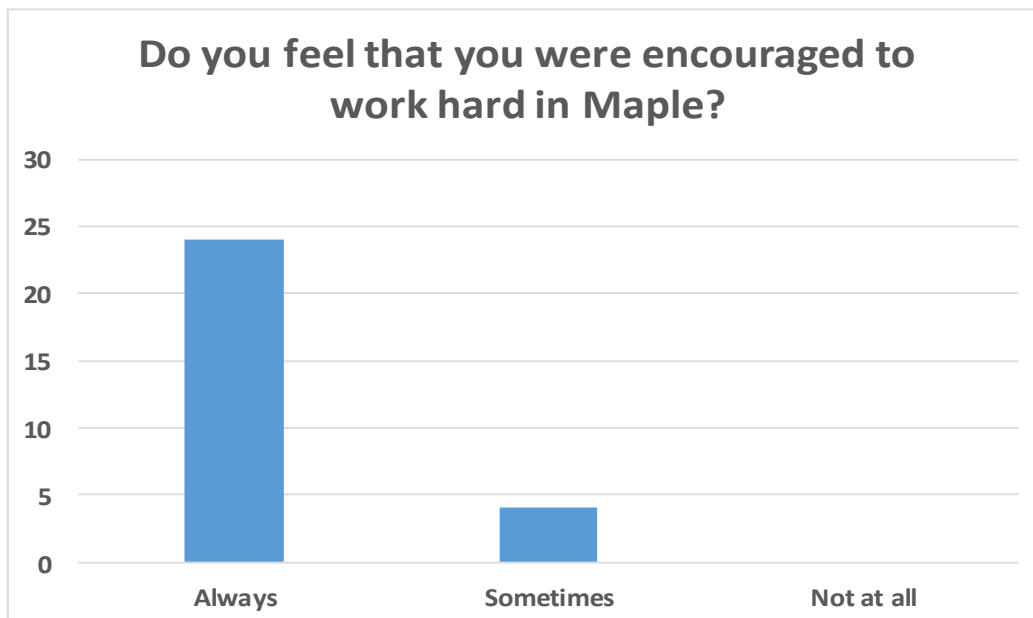
Most pupils (96%) said that they felt safe in Maple. We had a judgement of outstanding for a Health and Safety inspection.

Question 5



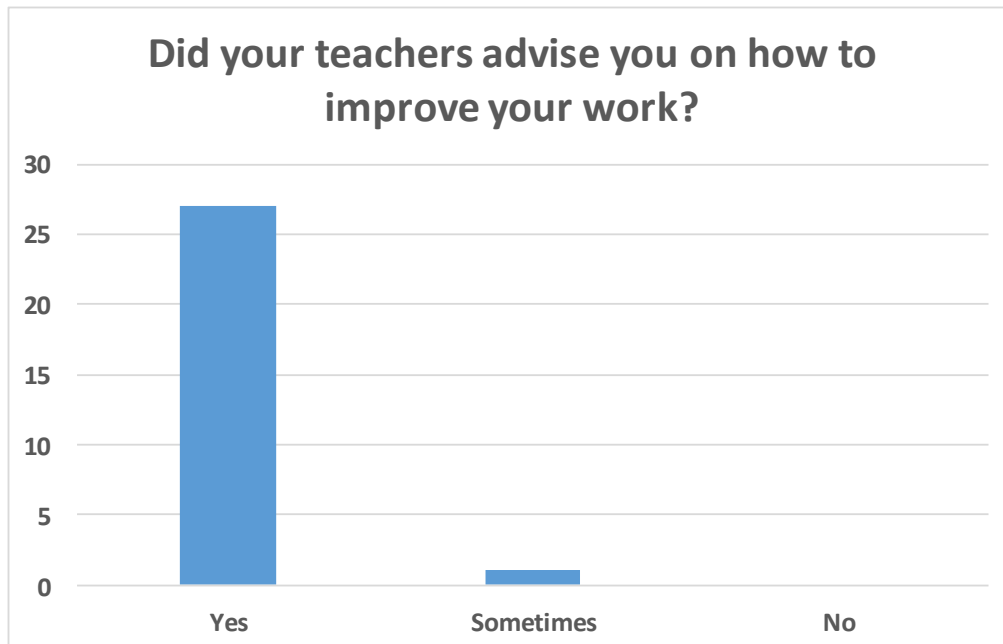

Question 6



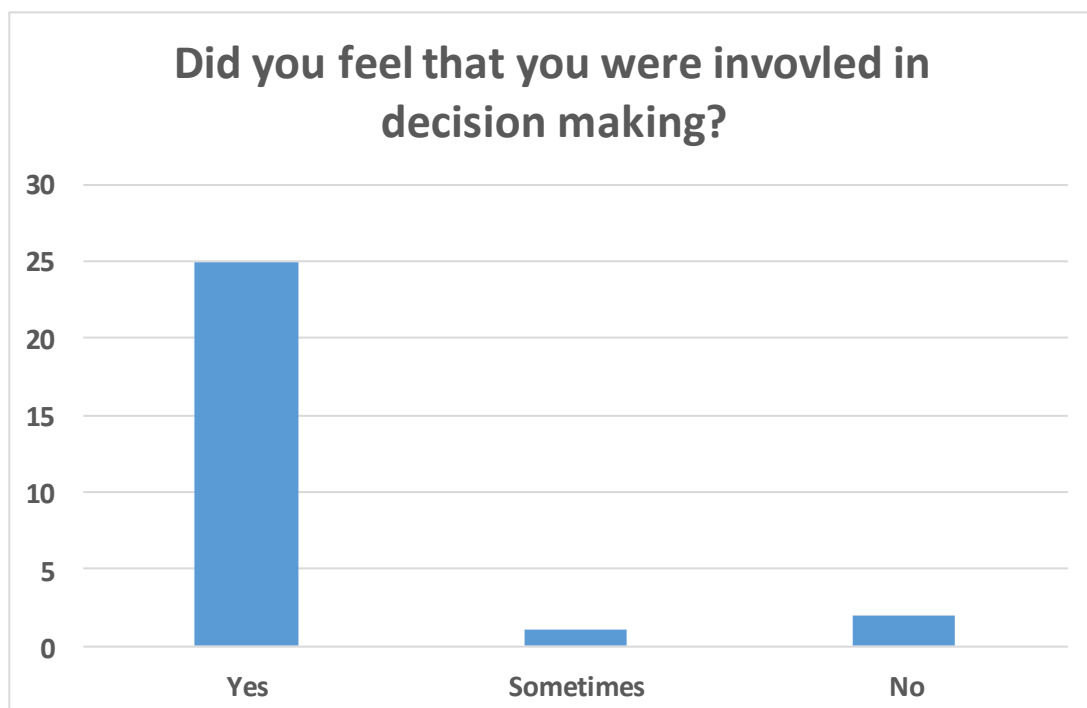

Question 7



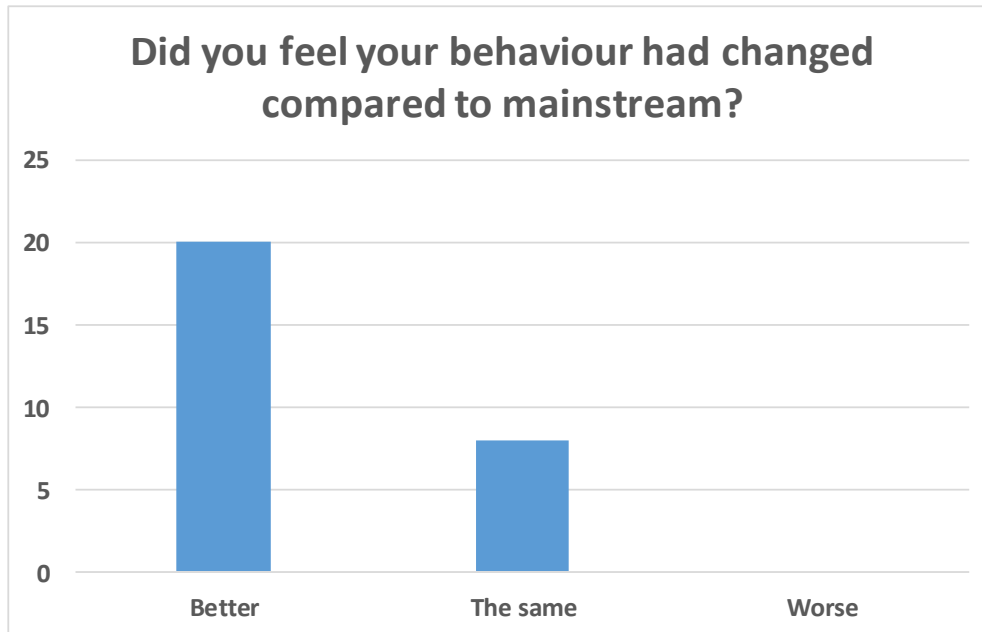

Question 8



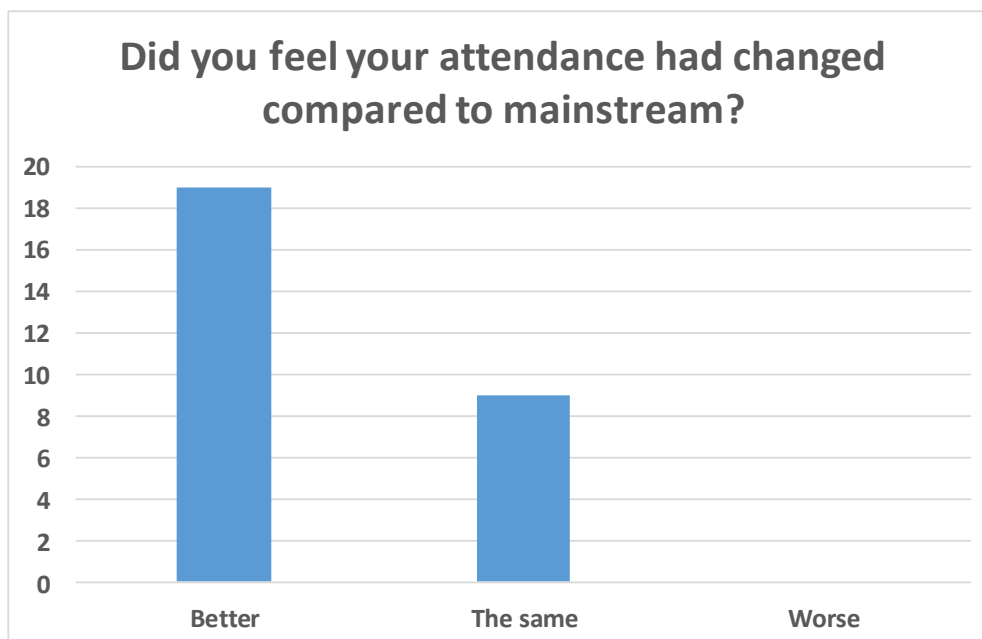
Pupils are consulted regularly and are able to have a voice in student council meetings. Most pupils (89%) felt they were consulted.

Most pupils (71%) report an improvement in their attitude and behaviour when coming to Maple. Inspections, Management Committee visits and StEP (Standard and Effectiveness Partner) visits confirm this.

Question 10



68% of pupils feel that their attendance improves at Maple compared to their previous attendance. Our records of attendance comparisons confirm this.
