

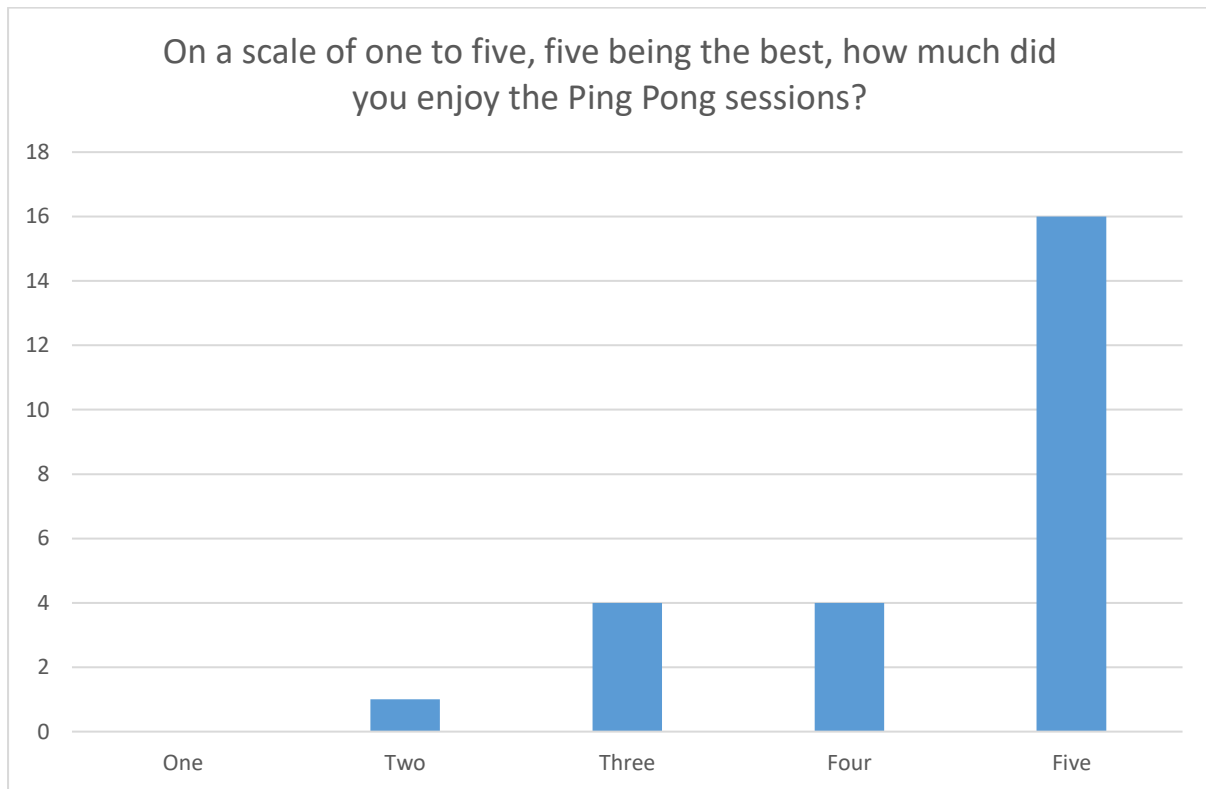
Ping Pong Pete's Table Tennis Sessions Survey

March 2023

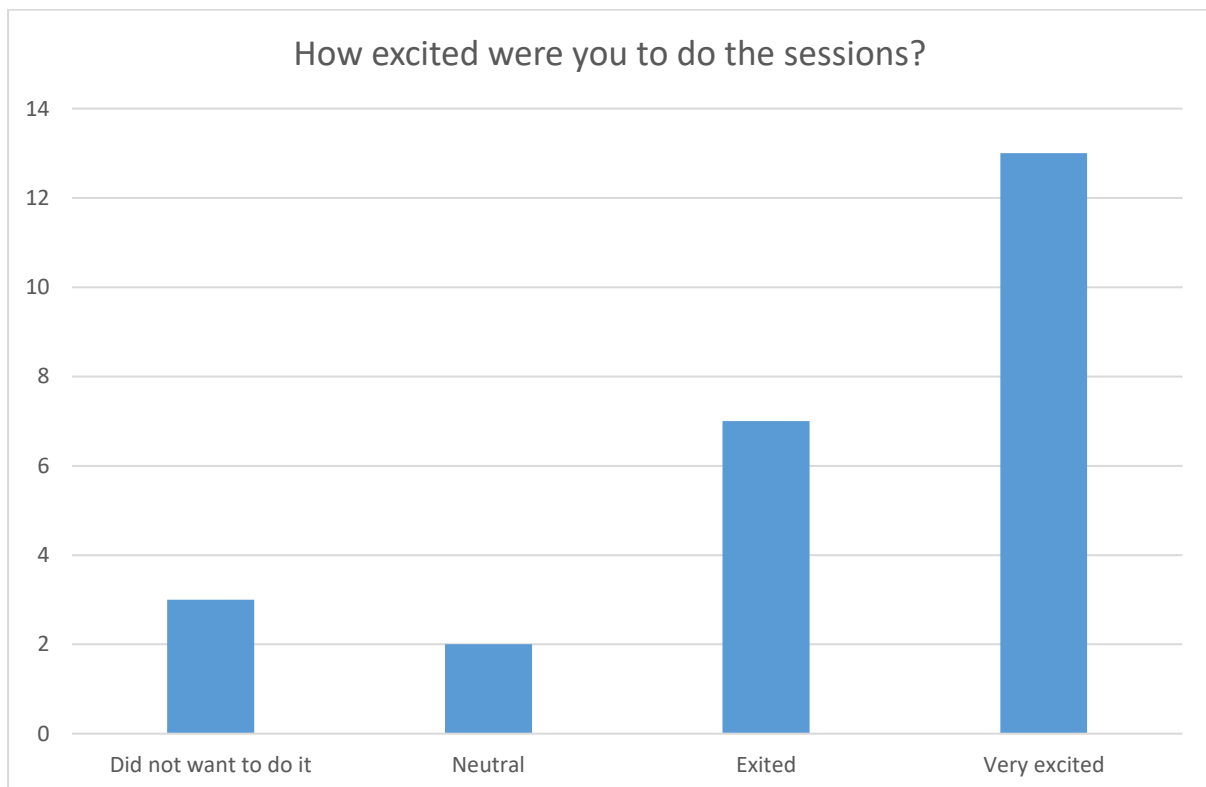
